
KARMA PEAT-FREE 9CM ANTHURIUMS





Peat is applied to provide the plants with more moisture retention and preservation of vitamins in the potting soil. This is obtained from peat areas, but it starts with cutting down trees and forests. Peatlands are formed there. This can lead to soil subsidence in the peat areas, causing flooding, but the risk of fire is also higher. It is a slow process but has many consequences for the climate because carbon is released into the air.
